

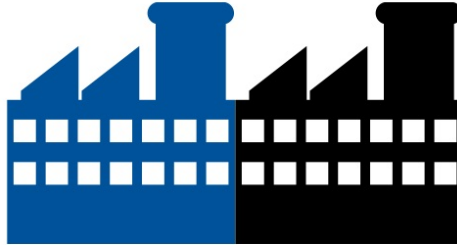


What is a Social Firm?
